**DOR issues 'Summary of Legislative Changes'**

*Publication also outlines incentives aimed at growing businesses, adding jobs*

PROVIDENCE, R.I. – The Rhode Island Department of Revenue’s Division of Taxation today posted the 2015 edition of its annual “Summary of Legislative Changes.”

Acting Department of Revenue Director David M. Sullivan said that the publication summarizes tax-related changes in the budget bill for fiscal 2016 (H 5900 Substitute A as amended), which was approved by the General Assembly and signed into law by Governor Gina M. Raimondo.

“Many of the changes were originally proposed by Governor Raimondo in her fiscal 2016 budget and are designed to help existing businesses grow, attract new businesses to Rhode Island, and create jobs,” Sullivan said.
